Assessment	Grades	When Tested	What Assessment Does	How SWS Uses the Scores
Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS)	K-6	Fall, Spring	Students take a math assessment, as well as a reading assessment that focuses on phonemic awareness and fluency.	Results are used to determine instructional strategies, and help guide differentiation in the areas of reading and math.
NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) and (MPEG)	K-8	Fall, Winter, Spring	MAP assesses student in reading, math and language usage.	Results are used by teachers to determine students' needs and assist teachers in differentiating instruction throughout the school year.
ACT Aspire	8	Winter	The ACT Aspire guides 8th grade students and assesses their knowledge to assist in high school course placement.	High schools use this score to assist in placement, begin preparation for ACT, and consider career directions. ACT Aspire includes four multiple choice tests: English, Math, Reading, and Science.
